ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for admission to the program, applicants must have:

- ▷ Bachelor's degree with at least a 3.0 GPA (on a 4.0 scale)
 - Students with GPA's between 2.5 and 3.0 may be admitted on a probationary basis
 - Career goals and objectives that are consistent with the program

APPLICATION PROCESS

To apply to the program, applicants must complete and submit the following:

- ▷ Graduate College application
 - Visit gradcollege.okstate.edu/apply to complete the online application
 - Submit the non-refundable application fee
 - Submit official transcripts from all previously attended institutions
- ▷ Program application
 - Current resume/vita
 - Personal statement
 - Two letters of recommendation
