The **Graduate Certificate in Program Evaluation** is designed for students seeking to become more knowledgeable in program evaluation skills. The certificate enables students to have a critical understanding of key program evaluation techniques, including how to plan and design evaluations and logic models. Students will also gain practice in carrying out an actual program evaluation as a result of completing this certificate.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered for admission to the program, applicants must complete and submit the following:

1. OSU Graduate College Application

- ▷ Visit gradcollege.okstate.edu/apply to complete the online application
- ▷ Submit the non-refundable application fee
- ▷ Submit official transcripts from all previously attended institutions

2. Program Application

- ▷ Statement of professional goals
- ▷ Two letters of recommendation

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis. Applicants will be notified of admission status within four to six weeks of submission. To be considered for admission to the program, applicants must have:

- ▷ Undergraduate degree from an accredited university with a minimum 3.0 GPA

COURSEWORK

Successful completion of the program requires 12 credit hours (four courses) of graduate-level coursework. Credit hours are transferable to other graduate degree programs at Oklahoma State University.

- ▷ REMS 6373 Program Evaluation I
- ▷ REMS 6383 Program Evaluation II

Choose one of the following:

- ▷ SCFD 4913 Introduction to Qualitative Inquiry
- ▷ SCFD 6123 Qualitative Research I
