TRANSFER ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: 2.00 for less than 31 hours; 2.25 for 31-45 hours; 2.50 for more than 45 hours.

GRADES: A grade of C or better is required in all DHM courses, major requirements, CHEM 1014 or 1215 & MATH 1483 or 1513.

INTERNSHIP: A 2.50 major GPA is required for full admission to the Internship Program.

GRADUATION: Total credit hours for graduation are 120 minimum.

GPA: A 2.50 major GPA is required. This includes all courses in College/Departmental and Major Requirements.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY: This is a four-year plan. Subject to modification in curriculum(s), offerings and scheduling. Students will be held responsible for degree requirements in effect at the time of matriculation (date of first enrollment) and any changes that are made, so long as these changes do not result in semester credit hours being added or do not delay graduation.

Additional State/OSU Requirements— At least: 60 hours at a four-year institution; 30 hours completed at OSU; 15 of the final 30 or 50% of the upper-division hours in the major field completed at OSU. Limit of: one-half of major course requirements as transfer work; one-fourth of hours earned by correspondence; 8 transfer correspondence hours. Students will be held responsible for degree requirements in effect at the time of matriculation and any changes that are made, so long as these changes do not result in semester credit hours being added or do not delay graduation. Degrees that follow this plan must be completed by the end of Summer 2021.
