AVED 2113, 3433, 3513, and 4663 were removed from the standard AADO/ARLG 4-year plan and replaced with AERO courses. NOTE 1: Cadets who do not take AERO 2111 and 2211 must add AVED 2113 to this 4-year plan. NOTE 2: Replacing all three upper-division AVED courses requires student to enroll in AERO 3504 after field training.

Sixty (60) hours must be completed at a senior college and must include forty (40) upper-division hours.

The student must have 120 total hours with a 2.50 graduation/retention GPA. A 2.50 GPA is required in the Major Requirements with no grade below a "C."
