GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN COLLEGE TEACHING



OVERVIEW

The Graduate Certificate in College Teaching is a part of the curriculum studies program in the College of Education and Human Sciences. The certificate develops and improves knowledge, skills and capacities for successful college teaching, as well as advances teaching vision, philosophy and adaptability in a rapidly changing society at a range of institutions of higher education. Courses are offered online and on campus in Stillwater and Tulsa.

APPLICATION

To be considered for admission to the program, applicants must complete and submit the following:

- OSU Graduate College application online at gradcollege.okstate.edu/apply
- Transcripts from all previously attended institutions
- Professional goal statement indicating the applicant's objectives in pursuing this certificate (approx. 250 words)
- Two letters of professional recommendation indicating the applicant's potential for successful graduate study
- Curriculum vitae or academic resume indicating the applicant's professional background and experience

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis. Applicants will be notified of admission status within four to six weeks of submission. To be considered for admission to the program, applicants must have:

Undergraduate degree from an accredited university with a minimum 3.0 GPA
