OVERVIEW

Students in the School Library Certification graduate certificate program will have the opportunity to complete requirements for School Library Media Specialist certification through the State Department of Education. Curriculum includes educational technology, library and information sciences, and literacy education. The objectives of the program are aligned to the American Library Association/American Association of School Libraries ((ALA/AASL).

ADMISSION

To be considered for admission to the program, applicants must complete and submit the following:

- Current teaching certificate
- Written Statement of Goals
