

OSU Check Sheet for Teacher Certification and Recommendation for Agricultural Education (grades 5-12)

(Successful Completion of these requirements DOES NOT result in completion of a degree)

- ☐ Apply for Admission to Professional Education (must apply first semester)
- ☐ Requirements for Full Admission to and Retention in Professional Education (cannot be waived)
 - ☐ Maintain a 2.50 Overall Cumulative Retention GPA (includes all undergraduate and graduate coursework for grad students)
 - ☐ Minimum General Education GPA of 2.75 in 30 hours or more across general education courses **OR** ACT (with writing) minimum of 22 required **OR** SAT with minimum score of 1120 and writing section scores of 5 for Reading, 4 for Analysis, and 5 for Writing **OR** Pass the PRAXIS Core Academic Skills for Educators Test **OR** hold a Bachelor's degree.
 - ☐ "C" or better in a Foundations of Education Course (AGED 3103) **AND** a Field Experience course (AGED 3101)
- ☐ Grade of "C" or better in CIED 4133 Introduction to K-12 English Language Learners **OR** Pass the Intro to K-12 English Learners micro credential course **OR** Demonstrate competency in a foreign language (2 years of HS in the same language with grades of "B" or better, or 3 college hours with a grade of "C" or better)
- ☐ Pass the Trauma Informed Practices and Legal Issues in Education training with a 100% (completed during student teaching semester)
- ☐ Pass the Certification Exams for Oklahoma Educators:
 - ☐ OSAT-Agricultural Education **OR** Praxis-Agriculture (**Must take prior to student teaching placement**)
 - ☐ Assessment of Professional Knowledge for Secondary (054)
- ☐ Hold a bachelor's degree from OSU in Agricultural Education (includes coursework listed below), **OR** approved double major, **OR**
- ☐ Hold a bachelor's degree and complete the following coursework:

- ☐ Enrichment: 12 hours (to be determined and listed by certification advisor)

- ❖ OSBI Criminal History and Sex Offender Background Check required during first field experience course.
- ❖ Additional state requirements include Federal Fingerprinting Background Check and passing the U.S. Naturalization test.
