Organization or Site Requirements
All new sites (not currently on file with the AVED Coordinator) will need to be approved. Organizations or Internship sites must meet the following requirements to be approved: a) The Organization must have a desire to participate in an AVED educational program for the purpose of improving the preparation of aviation professional personnel. b) There must be evidence of a sound professional philosophy and sound administrative procedures in the Organization's operation of programs and services. c) The Organization must have capable staff at a level qualified to provide organization oversight of activities of student Interns.

- d) The Organization should provide the Intern with appropriate workspace.
- e) Discussions should occur between the host Organization and the Intern to ensure that liability coverage is established for both parties.
- f) The organization is not required to pay a monetary stipend to the Intern or OSU, nor should it be a prime consideration in the Internship program. However, organization provided financial compensation (or other remuneration such as room and board) to the Intern is acceptable.
