40 hours of upper-division course work. Required for graduation and recommendation for Standard Certification: (1) 2.50 overall GPA; (2) 2.50 GPA in Major Requirements; and (3) 2.50 GPA in Professional Core Requirements. The student must earn minimum grades of "C" or "P" in the Major Requirements and Professional Core Requirements, and must earn grades of "P" in all sections of student teaching for recommendation for Certification. The student must earn minimum grades of "C" or "P" in the College/Departmental requirements.				
Prior to enrollment in the student teaching experience the student must: a) have all course work completed, and b) demonstrate proficiency in a foreign language at the novice high level from among those languages identified by the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation.				
Additional State/OSU Requirements – At least: 60 hours at a four-year institution; 30 hours completed at OSU; 15 of the final 30 or 50% of the upper-division hours in the major field completed at OSU. Limit of: one-half of major course requirements as transfer work; one-fourth of hours earned by correspondence; 8 transfer correspondence hours.				
Students will be held responsible for degree requirements in effect at the time of matriculation and any changes that are made, so long as these changes do not result in semester credit hours being added or do not delay graduation. Degrees that follow this plan must be completed by the end of Summer 2020.
