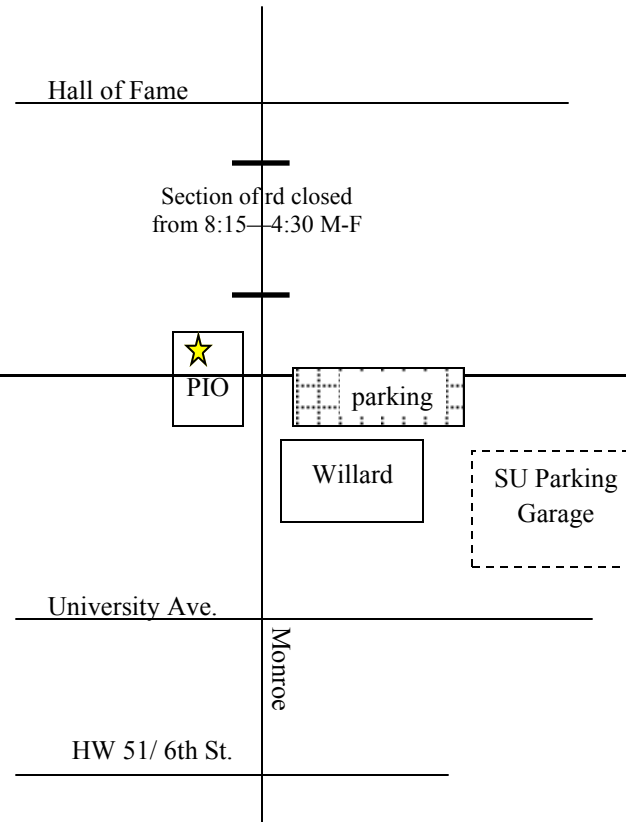


Hours vary each school semester. All sessions are scheduled based on appointment. Please call the center today and our clinic assistants will be happy to help you schedule an appointment.

SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGY SERVICES

The faculty and graduate students of the School Psychology program offers school psychological services for children and families serving as a liaison between you and your child's school to facilitate your child's success.

SERVICES PROVIDED

- **Consultation:** Professionals can provide consultation services for individuals, families, and schools or agencies. These services assist in preventing school failure and facilitating school success.
- **Interventions:** Professionals can develop interventions for learning difficulties as well as behavioral and emotional disorders for individuals and schools
- **Assessment:** Professionals can conduct assessments with children who are suspected of having learning problems or other difficulties or disabilities such as Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder, Learning Disabilities, Intellectual Disabilities, and various forms of Behavioral/Emotional Disorders.

SCIENCE-BASED CHILD/LEARNER SUCCESS

The center's philosophy is based on the training of the OSU School Psychology program which is embedded in the **Science-Based Child/Learner Success** (SBC/LS) orientation. This orientation emphasizes use of the scientific knowledge base and methodological rigor in the delivery of school psychology services to effect positive outcomes for our clients.

Our philosophy is that all children and youth have the right to be successful. Success refers not only to accomplishment of immediate goals but also to long range goals of adulthood such as maximizing personal potentials, social integration, meaningful work, and contributing to society. The SBC/LS orientation focuses on prevention and intervention services related to the psychoeducational and mental health needs of children and youth.

PARKING

Free parking is available in the spot designated *Reading and Math Center* in the lot north of Willard Hall. Additional parking is available in the Student Union Parking Garage for a fee. Ask the clinic assistant for details.

FEES

As stated on the Fee Schedule Form, assessment services are provided on a flat fee basis (\$150). A per test fee is then added to this flat fee. Please ask a clinic assistant or your case manager about per test fee rates. Three to five 1-hour sessions are typically needed to administer and review results of the assessment information. Typically, total fees fall somewhere between \$200 and \$250 per case. These fees are due upon completion of the case.

Consultation and intervention services are provided on a per session fee basis. Charges for these services are determined by the client's gross family income and number of dependents.
